A concentration in Organizational Behavior is an excellent choice for students who are interested in the behavior of and interactions between individuals in organizations. Organizational behavior prepares students for many career paths because it gives students the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed in a diverse and rapidly changing workplace. Students are exposed to a variety of subjects including ethics, conflict management, leadership, motivation, and decision-making. A concentration in organizational behavior is a great choice for students interested in jobs such as human resources, training and development, organizational change, consulting, and organizational development.

The concentration consists of 12 credit hours, three hours to be selected from [BA 4332](#), [BA 4333](#), or [BA 4380](#); and nine hours to be selected from [BA 3301](#), [BA 4306](#), [BA 4307](#), [BA 4309](#), [BA 4332](#), [BA 4333](#), [BA 4339](#), [BA 4380](#), or [BA 4199](#) and [BA 4299](#).
